



10 ROUTINE VEHICLE MAINTENANCE MONITORING CHECKLIST

1. Engine Oil & Filter

- Check oil level and color weekly.
- Replace oil and filter as per manufacturer's schedule.

2. Coolant/Antifreeze Level

- Inspect coolant reservoir regularly.
- Ensure the mixture is at the right level to prevent overheating.

3. Brake System

- Monitor brake fluid levels.
- Check brake pads, rotors, and responsiveness.

4. Tire Condition & Pressure

- Inspect tread depth and look for uneven wear.
- Maintain recommended tire pressure.

5. Battery Health

- Check for corrosion on terminals.
- Test battery charge regularly.

6. Lights & Electricals

- Test headlights, brake lights, indicators, and dashboard lights.
- Replace faulty bulbs immediately.

7. Transmission & Power Steering Fluid

- Inspect fluid levels and quality.
- Top up or replace as needed.

8. Belts & Hoses

- Look for cracks, wear, or fraying.
- Replace before failure.

9. Air Filter & Cabin Filter

- Inspect and replace clogged filters for better engine efficiency and air quality.

10. Wipers & Windshield Washer Fluid

- Check wiper blade condition.
- Ensure washer fluid is filled for clear visibility.
